

The developmental path in the life of a youth can be marked with landmarks with effective grooming, counseling and mentoring. It is important to arm youths with a critical lens that helps them reflect on their own thinking, refine their learning and give them new perspectives on existing issues.

EDI gives youth, from across the nation, a platform to cultivate such a personality which increases their confidence in self.

Over last 22 years, EDI has been imparting such unique exposure to youth through its **National Summer Camp on Entrepreneurial Adventures for Youth**. The camps have, shaped around 1087 youth from across the country. This year, the Institute has announced two such camps, the 27th and 28th in the series, which are scheduled during 11-20 May, 2015 & 01-10 June, 2015.

## **Main Objective:**

The youth realize their hidden potential and develop their capabilities to meet the challenges ahead by acquiring entrepreneurial traits of risk taking, creative thinking, conflict management, effective communication, teamwork and managing one's emotions.

#### **Activities:**

- Entrepreneurial motivation, development games and exercises to foster traits such as; creativity, concern for excellence, leadership, problem solving, independence, goal setting, etc.
- Formal and informal interaction with successful achievers and entrepreneurs.
- Evaluation and development of entrepreneurial traits and competencies.
- Visits to institutions of repute to analyse the process of creation and development.
- Self-assessment through specifically designed psychological tests, instruments and learning through recording presentation on self (Camera Presentation).
- Career and psychological counseling.

## **Venue and Accommodation:**

The camp will be organized at the Institute's lush green and international award-winning campus at Ahmedabad. A comfortable AC accommodation on twin-sharing basis will be provided to the participants.

#### Fee:

₹ 19,000/- (plus 12.36% Service Tax), which will include tuition fee, course material and board & lodging at the campus. It does not include any travel cost, out-of-pocket expenses and medical insurance.

At the behest of Instructor Training Centre (ITC), Technical and Vocational Training Organization (TVTO) of the Govt. of Iran, EDI conducted two, oneweek camps for Children (in the age group of 12-15 years) and Youth (in the age group of 16-22 years) representing various parts of Iran. The camps were customized to suit the requirements of 75 participants in all, and were based on the summer camp model of EDI.

#### The Institute:

Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDI), Ahmedabad is an autonomous and not-for-profit institution, set up in 1983 and sponsored by apex financial institutions, the IDBI Bank Ltd., IFCI Ltd., ICICI Bank Ltd. and the State Bank of India (SBI). 
