City start-up's cervical cancer screening method secures CDSCO approval





A city-based med-tech start-up has secured Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO) approval for its innovation, the M-Strip device that potentially helps women opt for cervical cancer screening by self-sampling at home. The method, which uses menstrual blood, was created following a study conceptualised by Dr Somesh Chandra, the principal investigator, and carried out in collaboration with Sterling Accuris.
