EDII trained 16,500 bizwomen in last 6 yrs

Ahmedabad: The Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII) has trained over 16,500 women across India in last six years. In collaboration with national and global partners, such as United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), the premier institute has designed programmes ranging from technology to rural livelihood to cater to a wide array of aspiring women entrepreneurs. Around 8,500 women with
