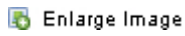

EDI to hold summer camps on entrepreneurship for youth

A host of summer camps, to celebrate the spirit of entrepreneurship, will be organised at the Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDI) this year. Out of the various camps, the two camps to look forward to are a camp for the youth and a camp for children.

“Youths, who are pillars of the society, particularly need to showcase entrepreneurial qualities and orientation to achieve memorable feats in life. Entrepreneurship, which has come to be recognised as a formal discipline, encompasses the values of creativity, self confidence, leadership, perseverance and the spirit of innovation.

It induces holistic development in those who are trained to acquire this. Youths, especially in the age group of 16-22 years, are on the threshold of making significant choices related to their life and career, and necessarily need that winning entrepreneurial acumen to excel. Our summer workshops target such a group,” said Dr Panjak Bharti, Faculty at EDI.

The camps for youth are scheduled from May 11 – 20 and June 1 – 10. Registrations for the camp are now open and more information can be procured on www.ediindia.org.

EDI will also organise one-week summer camp on ‘Entrepreneurial Stimulation’ for Children in the age group of 12-16 years.

The basic objective of this camp is to impart a winning edge in the thought process of these children, by inclining them to some impact-creating entrepreneurial traits and habits. The sessions, therefore, focus on enhancing creativity and motivation that make them think out-of-the-box. The children are also exposed to yoga and value education classes. Industrial visits to various small-scale setups in the city so as to acquaint them with the actual production procedures are also given priority.

“Children even get to experience the spirit of enterprise. Based on the guidance of EDI experts and their own creativity, the children are encouraged to set up their own small enterprises and earn money by working strictly within EDI campus,” added Dr Pankaj. These camps are scheduled from May 3–8 and May 24 – 29. Registrations are now open for the same.
