

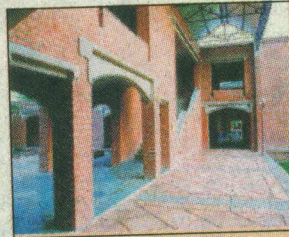
Training on NGO governance held
