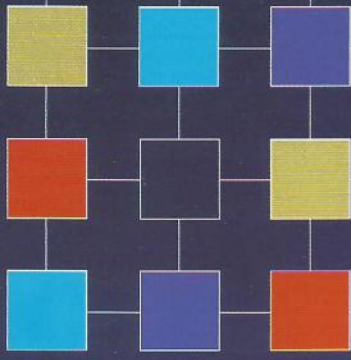

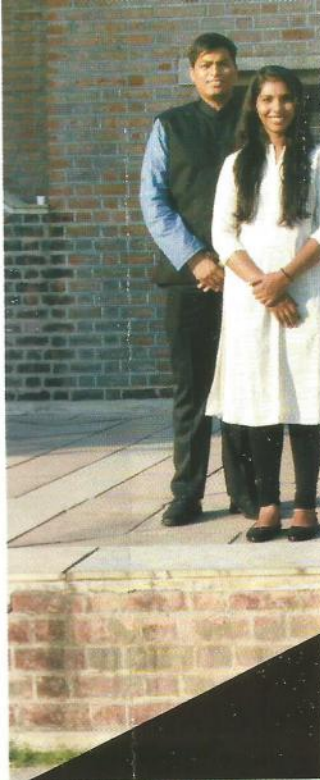

Course Design and Pedagogy

The course design is structured around the major components of class room learning, field trip education, development internship and seminar/colloquium drill. The course design follows a contemporary pedagogy comprising of interactive lectures, project based workshops, case analysis, organizational visits, field learning, experience sharing with development professionals and task based simulation exercises. At every juncture a student's competencies are gauged in all the components of the course through tests, presentations and interviews. The overall objective which is pursued through the course design and the pedagogy is to create a constructive bent of mind towards development as a discipline by developing the right knowledge, skills and attitude.

The PGDM-DS course has embraced the experiential learning model to impart hard-core occupational skills to the students. Experiential education components are conceived with an eye on both the process of learning and the outcomes. Theme based colloquiums, workshops and conferences are carefully designed to involve students and encourage them to brainstorm so that their learnings are reinforced.

- You are a budding social entrepreneur with a vision to develop the world, who aim to identify innovative solutions to social problems and are strongly committed to take up the challenges of solving these social problems.

You are eligible if:

You are a Graduate from any discipline, with a minimum of 15 years (10+2+3) of education and having 50 percent or above, (45 percent or above for SC/ST candidates) aggregate marks at the graduation level. EDII accepts CAT/MAT/XAT/CMAT/ATMA scores for admission to the programme. In addition, EDII conducts its own test and personal interview.

Introduction Programme

This programme brings the participants close to socio-economic and anthropological issues & context. As aspiring development professionals they are oriented and sensitized to development issues and best practices within the institutional paradigm.

Internship/Field Work/ Research

One of the critical learning tools designed in this programme is the internship project work with development organisations spread all over the country. For a period of eight weeks, students are placed with the organisations where they carry out projects as per the requirements of the respective organizations. The internship project helps the students relate theory to practice and provides them hands-on experience of development initiatives.



Fee structure and schedule

Fees for the two-year, full-time, residential course that includes cost of tuition, reading material, library and computer facilities, study visits, alumni association membership and students' activities is ₹6,42,000/- (payable in 6 instalments over 2 years). It also includes caution money deposit of ₹10,000/-, which does not accrue any interest, and will be refunded on successful completion of the course. Hostel charges will be ₹70,000/- per year (AC on twin-sharing basis). Mess charges will be as per the rates decided by the Institute.

The Institute

Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII) – an acknowledged National Resource Institute for entrepreneurship education, research, training and institution-building – is an autonomous and not-for-profit institute, set up in 1988. It is sponsored by apex financial institutions viz. IDBI Bank Ltd, IFCI Ltd, ICICI Bank Ltd and the State Bank of India (SBI). The Government of Gujarat pledged 23 acres of land on which stands the majestic and sprawling EDII campus. To pursue its mission, EDII has helped set up 13 state-level, exclusive Entrepreneurship Development Centres and institutes. EDII has also set up EDCs at Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, and Vietnam, and is in the process of setting up such centres at Uzbekistan and five African countries.



To widespread training and research in different sectors and, to target different segments of the society, the institute has set up six centres of higher learning – Centre for Research in Entrepreneurship Education and Development, Centre for Micro Enterprise, Micro Finance and Sustainable Livelihood, Centre for SMEs and Business Development Service, Centre for Cluster Competitiveness, Growth & Technology, Centre for Social Entrepreneurship & Corporate Social Responsibility and Centre for Women Entrepreneurship & Gender Studies.



The institute offers three full-time AICTE-approved courses, which include a four-year doctoral programme – the Fellow Programme in Management (FPM). It also offers a two-year Post Graduate Diploma in Management – Business Entrepreneurship (PGDM-BE) and a two-year Post Graduate Diploma in Management – Development Studies (PGDM-DS). While PGDM-BE courses focus at new enterprise creation and family business management verticals, the PGDM-DS course focusses on churning out social entrepreneurs. Both the courses involve milestone-based learning, wherein the students are encouraged to achieve stepping stones of their entrepreneurial journey well within the duration of the course. Based on their achievements, the students get bonus points on the basis of which they become eligible for seed funding for setting up their ventures.
