


on Entrepreneurial Stimulation for Children

ur young generation is filled with ample of soaring ambitions and energy which need to be effectively directed on the right path. The children in the age group of 12-16 years are buzzing with thoughts and emotions that need to be channelized properly. Hence, in order to ensure that the children of today develop a balanced approach to life and scan things from an innovative perspective, they require guidance and support at the right time of their life.

Over past 26 years, EDII has been offering a powerful platform to children across the nation to grow, evolve and experiment with their thoughts, ideas and get well acquainted with their personality. So far the institute has been successfully imparted unique exposure to children to build their competence, mindset and develop their personality as a whole.

EDI has been conducting Summer Camps on Entrepreneurial Stimulation for Children with this objective. Till date it has groomed 2349 children through these National Summer Camps. This year, the institute has announced two such camps, 34th & 35th in the series, which are scheduled on 05 – 10 May, 2019 and 26–31 May, 2019 respectively.

Main Objective:

The objective of the camp is to inculcate the 'Spirit of Enterprise and Achievement' in children so that they target higher achievements.

Highlights of the camp:

- 12 to 16 year old children are eligible. Adequate arrangements are made for girls, such as appointment of a lady caretaker.
- Since focus is on activities, there is no language bar. However, participants are expected to communicate in either of these languages: English, Hindi, and Gujarati.
- Activities include mental gyms, motivation and creativity exercises, puzzles, value education, presentations, learning through success stories, industry visits and 'yoga'.
- The number of participants is limited to 90 only. The entire group will be divided into two sub-groups of 12 to 14 years (Group-A) and 14 to 16 years (Group B).
- Enrollment will be on first-come-firstserve basis.
- A parents' meet will be organized to brief them on their ward's performance and potential.

Formal and informal interaction with well-known entrepreneurs and achievers from various fields will be organised to motivate the children to target mega successes in life.



Venue:

The camp will be organized at the award-winning EDI Campus, Ahmedabad. Well equipped, AC classrooms with modern amenities will be made available. First 50 participants would be accommodated in AC rooms on twin–sharing basis and the remaining would be provided aircooled rooms on twin–sharing basis.
