in the age group of 12-16 Years**

**(April 30 - May 05, 2006)**

### **Objectives**

The major objective of the camp is to inculcate the spirit of enterprise and achievement among children at this young age. The focus is on activities like mental gyms, motivation and creativity exercises, puzzles, value education, presentations, industry visits and interaction with 'Achievers' from different walks of life. The Institute has already organised twelve such camps at Ahmedabad and five in Lucknow and has been receiving excellent feedback from participants, their parents and teachers. Features of the camp are :

- 12 to 16 year old children, studying in standard seven to ten, are eligible. The number of participants is limited to first 35 only. Adequate arrangements are made for girls.
- Since focus is on activities, there is no language bar. However, participants are expected to communicate in either of these languages: English, Hindi or Gujarati.
- A parents' meet will be organized to share with them the experiences of the camp and brief them on the strengths and weaknesses of their ward. Reports will be sent to parents on their ward's / wards' performance and potential.
- Formal and informal interactions with well-known entrepreneurs and achievers from various fields.

The camp will be organized at the award-winning EDI Campus. Comfortable AC accommodation on twin-sharing basis will be provided.

### **Fee & Registration**

Rs. 6,000/-per participant, which includes tuition fee, camp material and board/ lodging. It does not include travel cost, out-of-pocket expenses and medical insurance, if any.

## THE INSTITUTE

Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDI), Ahmedabad is an autonomous and not-for-profit institution, set up in 1983 and sponsored by apex financial institutions, IDBI, IFCI Ltd., ICICI Ltd. and the State Bank of India (SBI). EDI has been spearheading entrepreneurship movement throughout the nation with a belief that entrepreneurs need not necessarily be born but can be developed through well-conceived and well-directed activities.

Under the thrust area, Entrepreneurship Education, EDI has been progressively focussing on the development of its academic programmes to disseminate the essence of the institute's professional knowledge-base amongst entrepreneurs of the morrow. Some of EDI's core activities under this thrust are Summer Camps for Youth and Children, Faculty Development Programmes, Researches and long term academic programmes which include Post-Graduate Diploma in Business Entrepreneurship and Management and Post-Graduate Diploma in Management of NGOs.

In view of EDI's expertise in Entrepreneurship, Gujarat Textbook Board assigned to it the task of developing textbooks in Entrepreneurship for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> standards. In its Faculty Development Programmes, as of now, around 925 teachers have developed their professional skills to conduct Entrepreneurship courses effectively. The institute plans to establish a network of Entrepreneurship Cells on college campuses. University Grants Commission had also assigned to EDI, the task of developing curriculum on Entrepreneurship.

The Institute has earned a great deal of national and international reputation by way of its entrepreneurship development efforts. It has also been selected as a member of the Economic and Social Commission for Asia and Pacific (ESCAP) Network of Centres of Excellence for HRD Research and Training. Sprawling EDI Campus has won the international award for Architecture and has latest training equipments and infrastructure.

Recently, the Institute has been entrusted with the task of setting up Entrepreneurship Development Centres in four South East Asian Countries, namely; Cambodia, Lao-PDR, Myanmar and Vietnam.

The Institute is also organising the 15<sup>th</sup> National Summer Camp on Entrepreneurial Adventures for Youth (during May 7 - 16, 2006). Last date for registration in this camp is 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2006.
