Significance of Training in Entrepreneurship

The international business scenario is looking up. A window of opportunities has opened up and potential entrepreneurs could not have had a more opportune time. But at the same time protectionism has given way to competition and so, there is a strong likelihood of entrepreneurs confronting numerous challenges from various quarters, lest they adhere to benchmarks, like; better products, lower costs, better quality, competitive prices and advanced technology. To achieve this requires up-to-date knowledge, which can be acquired through teaching and training in this area.

Using its accumulated wealth of knowledge, expertise and insight in creating successful entrepreneurs, the Institute developed and launched, in 1998, a one year (full time) pioneering programme for young graduates leading to the award of Post Graduate Diploma in Business Entrepreneurship and Management. Enriched by the experience of running the program successfully for ten batches, the Institute now announces two-year (full-time) Post Graduate Diploma in Management - Business Entrepreneurship.

Entrepreneurial wisdom and knowledge that this course imparts are unique and have earned All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) approval for the Institute. The course would now be offered as a two-year full-time residential programme.

PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this accelerated, rigorous and application-oriented programme are to:

 develop skills in successfully initiating, expanding and diversifying a business enterprise in new, up-coming areas, including agriculture and service sectors. develop family business successors as enterprising and knowledgeable owners of the business of their forefathers.

SPECIALISATION STREAMS

In keeping with the objectives, the course offers the following four specializations:

New Enterprise Creation (NEC):

The objective of this specialization is to provide knowledge and develop competencies to start and manage own independent business. Students opting for this specialization are guided to work on a detailed project report and emerge with a bankable business plan after completion of classroom training.

Family Business Management (FBM):

This specialization aims at developing family business successors into enterprising and knowledgeable owners of the business of their forefathers. Issues, problems and unique concerns of family business management are dealt with in great detail so as to enable the students to come out with a five-year growth plan.

Agri-Entrepreneurship (AE):

The primary objective of this specialization is to develop agri-preneurs who can operate in the agriculture sector, understand its nuances, exploit opportunities galore in this field and benefit from the latest schemes of the government to promote the sector.

Services Management (SM):

The objective is to facilitate conceptual understanding of the fast emerging service sector and its significance to the economy. The stream provides an in-depth analysis of the environment that leads to recognition of opportunities in the service sector. Students will be able to benefit from such opportunities and create and manage new ventures in this sector.

PEDAGOGY

The interactive nature of learning experience distinguishes EDI from many other institutions. The emphasis is on action learning. Business games, computer simulation, live projects, role plays, interaction with the experts, industrial visits, ase based teachings, field work and group work combine to create a challenging environment to define problems and find workable solutions. The focus of the internship programme will be on developing a Detailed Project Report or Family Business Growth Plan.

FACULTY

The faculty is a judicious mix of researchers, academicians, behavioural scientists, practitioners from varied disciplines and consultants. The core group is supplemented by visiting faculty from puted academic institutions and professional organisations.

WHO CAN JOIN?

- Graduates who intend to launch and manage business units
- Wards / successors of family businesses intending to develop their potential successors in professional skills over a relatively shorter duration
- Young professionals envisioning own business and capable of investing one-year time away from work, learning about business entrepreneurship and management.

ELIGIBILITY / SELECTION

A bachelor's degree in any discipline. Students appearing for final degree examination may also apply. Candidates with work experience will be preferred. Selection will be on the basis of a written test and personal interview to gauge their commitment towards the chosen career. The written test will be held at Ahmedabad, Allahabad, Bangalore, Belgaum, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Chennai, Delhi, Gorakhpur, Guwahati, Gwalior, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Jodhpur, Kolkata, Lucknow, Ludhiana, Madurai, Mumbai, Nagpur, Patna, Pune, Raipur, Ranchi, Thrissur, Udhamsingh Nagar and Vadodara.

FEE STRUCTURE

- Tuition fee for this two-year, full-time, residential programme is Rs. 1,80,000/- per year which includes cost of tuition, reading material, library & computer facilities, study visits and lodging & boarding.
- In case the Institute is not able to provide accommodation to a few students, the fee applicable will be Rs. 1,20,000/- per year. This would include, cost of tuition, reading material, library & computer facilities and study material only.
- Fees can be paid in installments. (for details refer our website)
- Students will also have to deposit Rs. 5,000/- as caution money, which does not accrue any interest, and is refundable after successful completion of the course.

FELLOWSHIP SUPPORT

A limited number of fellowships, from Bharti Foundation (established by the Bharti Enterprises) is available for supporting PG students on means-cummerit basis.



THE INSTITUTE



An acknowledged National Resource Institute for entrepreneurship education, research and training.

Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDI), an autonomous and not-for-profit institute, set up in 1983, is sponsored by apex financial institutions -[IFCI Ltd., ICICI Ltd. and State Bank of India (SBI). The Government of Gujarat pledged twentythree acres of land on which stands the majestic and sprawling EDI campus. To pursue its mission further, EDI has helped set up fourteen state-evel exclusive entrepreneurship development centres and institutes. One of the satisfying achievements, however, was taking entrepreneurship to a large number of schools, colleges, science and technology institutions and management schools in several states by including entrepreneurship inputs in their curricula. In view of EDI's expertise in Entrepreneurship, the University Grants Commission had also assigned EDI the task of developing curriculum on Entrepreneurship, and Gujarat Textbook Board assigned to it the task of eloping textbooks in Entrepreneurship for 11th & 12th standards.

In order to broaden the frontiers of Entrepreneurship Research, EDI has established a Centre for Research in Entrepreneurship Education and Development (CREED), to investigate into a range of issues

In recognition of its international achievements, the United Nations Economic & Social Commission for Asia and Pacific (UN-ESCAP), Bangkok, Thailand, has declared EDI as a 'Center of Excellence'.
