The Programme

The Post Graduate Diploma in Management of NGOs (PGDMN) bridges the knowledge and skill gap so as to address the need of well managed, pro-active and people-oriented developmental non-government organisations. The course, therefore;

- equips people to set up own NGOs,
- helps NGOs manage resources effectively and efficiently by training its functionaries,
- establishes new and strategic partnerships with donors and
- creates a force, which substantially brings forth the importance of the development sector and the significance that is due to it.

Salient Features

- Qualifies people in social planning and management of development programmes.
- Creates and develops Managers with the required vision and skills to make effective decisions, thus improving the overall organisational performance.
- Focuses on philosophical or the perspective domain; strategic management and decision-making domain; human resource management domain and the structures, systems, tools and technique domain (including monitoring and financial management).
- Beneficial for students with educational background in Economics, Sociology, Commerce, Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering, Animal Husbandry, Fisheries, Forestry, Social Work and Rural Development.
- Spread over four semesters, making a total of 780 hours of classroom inputs.
- Internship duration equivalent to around 12 credit hours (in collaboration with reputed Non Government Organisations spread across the entire country).

Eligibility

- 3 years' Bachelor's Degree or equivalent to any discipline
- Final year students can also apply provided they complete their degree examination by 30th June, 2005.

Selection

- National level entrance examination to be conducted at 35 locations across the country (for details visit our website: www.ediindia.org)
- Personal interview

Internship and Placement

- PGDMN students get placed with NGOs of repute for their Internship, a period during which they put their classroom learnings into practice.
- National and international NGOs approach EDI for campus and off campus placements. The pass-outs of this course are involved in significant development projects on account of their recruitment in renowned NGOs.

Applications and Fee

- Fee for non-residential candidates is Rs.65000/- (cost of teaching and training material, computer and library facilities) and for residential candidates, it is Rs.115000/- (cost of teaching and training material, computer and library facilities and boarding and lodging).
- Application forms can be obtained from EDI Ahmedabad on payment of Rs.500/- by cash or demand draft drawn in favour of EDI, Ahmedabad.
- Students can even download the application form from the website and send us the same along with the demand draft of Rs. 500/-.

Fellowship Support & Bank Loans

- Support to students on means-cum-merit basis.
- Financial Institutions provide support to students desirous of joining the course. Students seeking loans must contact banks in their area of domicile.
