#### A. Institutionalising Entrepreneurship Development & Institution Building

In Institution Building EDI organises

- Entrepreneurship Development Programmes (EDPs) to demonstrate the efficacy and replicability of EDP as a tool to create entrepreneurial awareness as also to identify, select, train and develop firstgeneration entrepreneurs from nontraditional, non-commercial target groups.
- EDPs for specific target groups to achieve a special objective.
- Training programmes for Teachers of Engineering/Polytechnic institutions of various states for providing an orientation on Entrepreneurship Development to help them initiate courses on Entrepreneurship in their respective institutions.
- Accredited Trainers' Course to provide trained man-power to EDP conducting organisations for organising result-oriented EDPs and produce well-rounded entrepreneurs for identifying, planning, implementing and profitably running commercially viable enterprises.
- Skill Development Programmes for sharpening the knowledge and skills of Entrepreneur Trainer-Motivators (ETMs) and Appraisal Officers of State Finance Corporations in assessing entrepreneurial competencies.

- Programmes for Existing Entrepreneurs for strengthening their entrepreneurial competencies to help them manage their enterprises effectively and design strategy for expansion/growth.
- Interaction with officials of support organisations/Industries Departments of various governments for allocating adequate funds for entrepreneurial development activities.

#### B. Sensitising Environment

To create a conducive environment for the blossoming of new entrepreneurs, EDI organises the following programmes :

- Orientation Programmes in entrepreneurship development and co-related activities for the implementation-level officers of the support organisations.
- EDP Appreciation Programmes for senior and policy-level officers to make them conversant with all the aspects of and issues involved in entrepreneurship development.
- Extension Motivation Programmes to help officers of support organisations in selfintrospection and to sensitise them towards others' needs so that they extend best possible assistance to first-generation entrepreneurs.
- Seminars on New Selection Technique for assessing entrepreneurial capabilities.
- National Trainers' Meet and Chief Executives' Conference to share experiences in the field of ED amongst trainers from all over the country and discuss EDP related problems and issues.

#### C. New Markets Explorations

- New Training Modules for specific target groups are developed and experimental EDPs are conducted for target groups such as, women, ex-servicemen, science graduates in Agriculture, etc., for identifying their training needs. Special surveys, data collection and analysis of data on the development of training modules are undertaken.
- Research in the area of Entrepreneurship to understand the needs of small-scale entrepreneurs for promoting growth of their enterprises and development of entrepreneurial competencies for initiating export-oriented enterprises will be carried out. Seminars will be organised to share the findings of such research studies.
- Special audio-visuals are developed on important themes such as, Opportunity Guidance and Product Processes. Manuals for Project Report Preparation and Opportunity Guidance are also made available to the practitioners.

#### D. Resource - Knowledge Generation and Spread

- Studies are undertaken in critical areas of entrepreneurship development e.g. development of rural poor entrepreneurs, study of first-generation entrepreneurs, study of trainers' competencies, study of process of product selection by entrepreneurs, etc.
- Research projects such as, Evaluation of EDPs, Role of Rural Entrepreneur as a change-agent, Documentation of existing

courses and curricula in educational institutions, etc., are undertaken to focus on 'Environment and Intervention'.

- Workshops/Seminars are organised to share the knowledge on specific themes such as, Evaluation of EDPs, Problems & Prospects of Women Entrepreneurs, Impact Making Entrepreneurs, etc.
- Documentation, Evaluation, Working Papers, Research Studies, critical and creative Articles on ED and co-related activities are undertaken for publication purpose.


