THE PROGRAMME

India, like other developing countries, is confronted with the serious problem of mounting unemployment among educated youth. In order to deal with this problem as well as to develop first generation entrepreneurs, Entrepreneurship Development Programme (EDP) has been proved as an effective tool to motivate new-comers for taking up self employment and entrepreneurial careers. It has also been realised by the Indian planners that entrepreneurial values should be inculcated when the students are graduating to make them aware of Entrepreneurship as a possible career opportunity. Further, it may help convert creative energies, technical and scientific capabilities into productive resources, generate further employment, output and income.

To meet with the above objective, Department of Science & Technology (DST) has taken the initiative in introducing entrepreneurship as a course in Science & Technical Institutions. DST has also assisted a number of engineering colleges in creating Entrepreneurship Development Cell for organising ED activities in their colleges and nearby areas. However, for effective introduction of entrepreneurship as a course or conducting EDPs in technical institutions, it is important to develop human resources - teacher trainers on the subject. This will help in effectively organising, monitoring, controlling and imparting entrepreneurship development among students. Thus, for human resource development in entrepreneurship, DST, Govt. of India and IDBI, IFCI & ICICI have sponsored a training programme for teachers from technical institutions to be conducted by EDI.

OBJECTIVES

This programme aims :

- * To provide an effective package of entrepreneurship development programme inputs to the participants of science & technical institutions.
- * To develop and train trainers' skills, knowledge and resources for effective implementation of entrepreneurship in technical institutions.
- * To help evolve proper strategy, systematic approach and relevant training inputs for promoting youth, especially S&T students, for taking up entrepreneurial career.
- * To share rich experiences of EDP conducting agencies and to identify specific issues and problems related to developing S&T target group of entrepreneurs.

PROGRAMME CONTENT

In order to fulfil the above objectives, EDI has formulated a need-based training programme. This will enable teachers/professors to develop their skills in preparing, planning and implementing Entrepreneurship Development Programmes. The content of the programme may be broadly classified into the following areas :

- Entrepreneurs and entrepreneurship - A macro perspective.
- Selection procedure and new selection techniques.
- Identification of business opportunities.

- Feasibility and Project Report preparation.
- Market survey and Market Research.
- Behavioural inputs.
- Managerial inputs and management skills (decision-making, problem-solving, etc.)
- Role of Trainer-Motivators.
- Strategies and plans for introducing entrepreneurship in technical institutions/Colleges.

FACULTY

Faculty for the programme will include experienced faculty team of EDI and resource persons/experts from National and state level financial institutions, Technical Consultancy Organisations, University Departments, Department of Science & Technology, etc.

VENUE & DURATION

The programme will be conducted at Cuttack from September 22 to October 6, 1989.

PARTICIPATION

Participation is free but limited to the teachers of Engineering Colleges & Polytechnics. Participants will be reimbursed to & fro first class rail fare or deluxe bus fare by shortest route. Organisational sponsorship will be essential in all cases. EDI will provide Board/Lodging facilities to the participants.

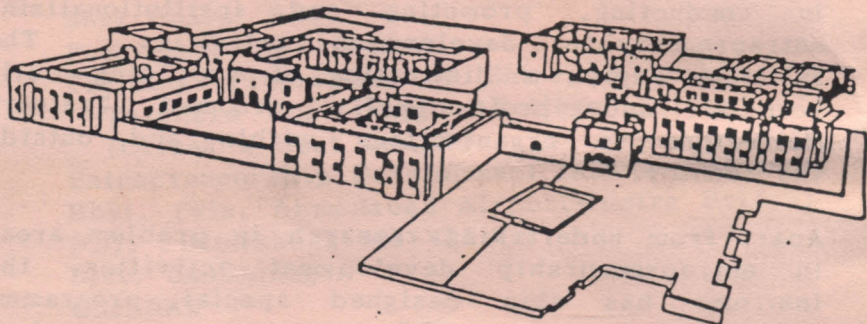
