- Any Institution or NGO, conducting entrepreneurship development training can also nominate its trained entrepreneur who has five years of experience in business.

### Selection Criteria

A jury consisting of eminent professionals and educationists would shortlist the eligible applications. The short listed candidates would be invited at EDI Campus, Ahmedabad for personal interaction with the jury. The personal interaction would explore the vision, roadmap and strategies conceived to tackle rough times in business and future directions.
