

Eligibility

- A regular EDP-trained first-generation entrepreneur emerging from preferably a non-business community and possessing experience of five successful years in business is eligible 'Bharti Entrepreneur of the Year' Award.
- Any Institution or NGO, conducting entrepreneurship development training can also nominate its trained entrepreneur who has five years of experience in business.

Selection Criteria

A jury consisting of eminent professionals and educationists would shortlist the eligible applications. The shortlisted candidates would be invited at EDI Campus, Ahmedabad for personal interaction with the jury. The personal interaction would explore the vision, roadmap and strategies conceived to tackle rough times in business, and future directions.
