ABOUT THE INTERNATIONAL INTERACTIONS

- (1) The Senior Training Faculty of EDI-I visited Cranfield Institute of Management, U.K. to impart Achievement Motivation Training to promotional officers of developing countries.
-
- (2) First Inter-Regional Workshop on Entrepreneurship Development for developing countries held in Ahmedabad from 7th to 19th January 1985. The programme was jointly sponsored by Economic Development Institute of the World Bank, Washington and The Industrial Development Bank of India, Bombay and hosted by the Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India, Ahmedabad. 27 participants from 8 countries attended this workshop.
-
- (3) At the request of the Development Bank of Mauritius, EDI-I team conducted one week EDP at Mauritius for 30 entrepreneurs financed by the Bank.
-
- (4) EDI-I team visited Nairobi, Kenya to conduct one-day Seminar which was attended by some 20 Chairmen and Managing Directors of various industrial assistance agencies, Secretary to the Govt., Advisers and Bankers.
-
- (5) EDI-I team conducted one full-fledged EDP in Nepal which was sponsored by the World Bank.
-
- (6) EDI-I team visited Mauritius and conducted 10-day programme for 29 young entrepreneurs including 4 women. The programme was sponsored by the Development Bank of Mauritius.
-
- (7) Mara Institute of Technology, Malaysia invited EDI-I team to conduct a Special Training Programme for its EDP trainers so that they could conduct more effective AMTs for new and existing entrepreneurs.

- (8) Second Inter-Regional Workshop on Entrepreneurship Development for developing countries was held in Ahmedabad between

- January 27 to February 01, 1986. The programme was jointly sponsored by the Economic Development Institute of the World Bank, Washington and the Industrial Development Bank of India, Bombay and hosted by The Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India, Ahmedabad. 17 participants from 12 countries attended this Workshop.

- (9) West Africa Division of the World Bank invited the Institute to visit Senegal to assess the possibilities of entrepreneurship development activity in the country.

- (10) EDI-I conducted 8 weeks Special Training Programme for 12 Instructors from Malawi to groom them in EDP training activities.
-
- (11) Two-member team of EDI-I conducted 3 days seminar organised by Nigerian Bank for Commerce & Industries which was attended by 80 participants.
-
- (12) EDI-I team conducted Inter-Regional Workshop on Entrepreneurship Development for French Speaking African countries in Abidjan. The Workshop was jointly sponsored by The World Bank and African Development Bank.

- (13) EDI-I organised 8 weeks Special Programme for 16 officers from Senegal, Togo & Guinea to groom them in EDP conducting activities.

- (14) EDI-I team visited Guinea to identify the possible business opportunities and make preliminary survey for institutionalising the EDP activities in the country.

- (15) Fourth Inter-Regional Workshop for South Pacific Island Countries which was sponsored by CHOGRM Working Group of Industry and hosted by The Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India, Ahmedabad. 14 participants from 12 countries attended this Workshop. It was held in Ahmedabad from February 23 to February 28, 1987.
