

States told to set up startup hub, incubators

New Delhi, July 6.

The Commerce and Industry Ministry has asked all the states and the Union Territories to set up 'Startup Hub' as well as incubators to help budding entrepreneurs.

The Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) has already set up the hub, which was operationalised since April. It helps in resolving queries and provides handholding support to startups.

The hub has been able to resolve 12,290 queries received from startups through telephone, e-mail and Twitter, the DIPP said in a status report on 'Startup India'

"DIPP has requested state

governments and the administration of UTs to set up Startup Hub as well as incubators to help startups during the various stages of development," it said.
