- Initially used CDS/ISIS till 2000
- Started Using Closed Source Software - LibSys from 2000 onwards on Windows NT Platform
- Used Libsys almost 16 years
- Effectively used almost all modules of LibSys
- Started using Web-Based OPAC since 2006

Reasons for Identifying New LMS



- Changed patterns of the users for accessing library resources
- Web OPAC of LibSys is not effective
- It is not interfaced with search engine based technology
- Annual Maintenance Services (AMS) / Annual Software Development (ASD) charges are high
- Heavy cost involved in migration from LibSys 4 to LibSys 7
- No Customization Support
- Not Flexible. Does not consider our suggestions

Identified New LMS - Koha



- IIMA Vikram Sarabhai Library successfully using Koha
- To Provide more user friendly access to WebOPAC
- To save the cost of Licensed software

(Availed the recommendation from Library Advisory Committee and approval from Director for migration from LibSys to Koha)
