State-level fee rules for CBSE schools

Fees charged by schools affiliated to the Central
Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) should be as
per the norms fixed by the
State government, CBSE
chairman R.K. Chaturvedi
said on Saturday.

"Our affiliation by-laws say the fee should be commensurate with infrastructure and facilities offered by the school. The quantum of fee should be on par with the (respective) state government's norms," Mr. Chaturvedi said.

Mr. Chaturvedi's statement comes even as CBSE schools have moved the Gujarat High Court against the State government's decision to regulate fees of all private schools, including the CBSE-affiliated institutions.
