

## EDII to train 100 Malaysian SME entrepreneurs

The Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII) will train around 100 Malaysian small and medium enterprises (SME) entrepreneurs in July and September. Under the Entrepreneur Growth Programmes, the institute will conduct 4 batches each of 25 entrepreneurs, as part of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed with the Malaysian government last year.

The training will be imparted to Malaysian youth in collaboration with IMS Asia, a Malaysian-based specialist in the arena of the IT Technology Training and Consulting under a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed by EDII with Pembangunan Sumber Manusia Berhad (PSMB) - or, Human Resource Development Fund (HRDF) - under Ministry of Human Resources, Govt. of Malaysia.
